- Diabetes
- Spina bifida / myelomeningocele
- Genu recurvatum
- Lower / Upper extremity fractures
- Scoliosis
- Pes planus
- Charcot-Marie-Tooth / Hereditary Motor Sensory Neuropathy
- Genu varum / valgum
- Kyphosis
- Metatarsus adductus
