High school opportunities

Reach out to high school teachers and organizations to see how you can connect with their students (e.g., speak at a career day, provide a class demonstration, or set up a mentorship program).

- Science departments
- Science or math honors societies
- Robotics/engineering clubs

College gigs

See how you can bring POP to your local college. Here are some ideas:

- Reach out to student groups with relevant interest in science/healthcare
- Contact alumni associations from your alma mater
- Offer to speak at Health 101 classes
- Connect with the career center/services where they offer student resources or career advice
- Contact administrators in the college of social and behavioral sciences
- Get involved in community college events
- Speak at technical centers (some students participate in dual-enrollment programs)
